**Please register for 2018-2019 transportation by May 30.
Bus lists will be finalized and sent to the bus company on June 1.**

Transportation must be requested every school year. TCA provides transportation for students living more than 1 mile from school. TCA will optionally provide a Metro Transit bus card for students in grades 9 – 12 or middle school students with no busing in their area. There is more information about the Metro Transit option on page 2. PSEO students are responsible for their own transportation.

Transportation can be requested in two ways:

1. By returning the *Intent to Return* form
2. By submitting the *Transportation Registration* form.

Metro Transit Go-To Student Pass Information

What is a Go-To Student Pass?

- A Go-To Student Pass is a durable, plastic card that allows unlimited rides on city buses and light rail to and from school instead of riding traditional yellow school buses.
- Passes can be used after school hours for other student activities. Students may also use their passes for extracurricular activities before and after school hours.
- Passes are good for the entire year. If a student loses their pass there is a \$10 fee for a replacement pass.

Benefits of the program

- Access to transportation before and after school and on weekends for sports, school events and extra curricular programs.
- Access to Metro Transit, seven days a week, for jobs, internships and community service.
- Greater flexibility before and after school for study groups, homework support and after-school programs.

When can I ride?

- Go-To Student Passes allow students to ride buses and trains from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week.
- Students who opt for the bus card are not eligible to ride TCA school buses.

Who is eligible?

- Students in grades 9 – 12 attending Twin Cities Academy.
- Students in grades 6 – 8 with no TCA school bus stop within a mile of their home.
- Students who qualify for school bus transportation and live more than one mile from school.
- Special Education students whose IEP (Individualized Education Plan) does not require special needs school bus transportation.
- Students who agree to follow the Metro Transit Go-To Student Pass Code of Conduct.

Lost Card?

- If a student loses their bus card it costs \$10 to get a replacement.
