

## TCA LEARNING MODEL METRICS

<b>ALL students in person</b>	<b>Transition to Hybrid (50/50)</b>	<b>Distance Learning w/ Supports</b>	<b>FULL Distance Learning</b>

**EXPLANATION:**

During the transition period, one/two grade(s) would be brought back at a time. This model takes the HIGHEST of case counts OR positivity to determine the current phase. If moving to a less restrictive learning model, the metrics must trend and hold within the new model's metrics for a minimum of 14 calendar days.

**EXAMPLE:**

If the case count is 37.85 and the positivity rate is at 5.8%, the learning model our school would use is "Distance Learning w/ Supports" (Orange), even though the positivity rate would fall within "Transition to Hybrid 50/50" (Blue).

**ADDITIONAL MITIGATION STRATEGIES IMPLEMENTED:**

- ALL students and staff must follow these 5 key mitigation strategies recommended by the Center of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC):
1. Consistent and correct use of masks.
  2. Social distancing to the largest extent possible.
  3. Follow hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
  4. Regular cleaning and disinfection.
  5. Contact tracing in collaboration with local health department(s).
- In addition to these key mitigation strategies, TCA will perform staff surveillance for symptoms every two weeks and use additional testing efforts, as possible.
