

A Message From Director Lueth

We are so excited to have all our students back in the building. So far so good - students are practicing all the safety measures we have in place and are even reporting enjoying being back in school. We are doing everything possible to keep them in school as well.

As a reminder, if your student is vaccinated, they will not need to quarantine if there is a close contact situation but are still advised to test as a precautionary measure. Please make sure we have your student's updated vaccine status on file by contacting Arlene Seashore at aseashore@twincitiesacademy.org or calling 651-205-4797.

Beginning this week TCA will also have rapid COVID tests to use if students come to the office feeling ill, or for asymptomatic testing as well. The best defense for all of us, is if you or your student is eligible to be vaccinated, please talk to your healthcare provider to get this done, if you haven't already. The only way to keep our school open long-term is through masking and vaccinating. We are also looking forward to hosting another vaccine clinic in the next few weeks, sponsored by Black Nurses Rock. As we tackle the physical health and safety of our students, we are also keenly aware of the academic and mental health needs of our students. As we begin to restore what we have lost during these past 15 months, and build on what we have gained, TCA is hosting several ways to make your voice heard as we plan for the future. I will also be hosting a Zoom call on Thursday September 16th at 6 p.m. for all families to attend and discuss with me their hopes and dreams for this upcoming year. WHAT ELSE?

- Missed Classes / Late to Class. Contact A+ Driving School www.aplusdrivingschool.net to schedule makeup online classes locations at no additional cost. 30 hours are required by the state. Students late to class will not get credit for that class.
- Classroom Lesson Completion. Students will receive a certificate upon completing 30 hours of instruction. Once a student is 15 years of age, they may take the permit test. Proof of classroom instruction (the certificate) is required at the DMV in order to take the permit test.


