Dear TCA families,

The IRT (Covid Response Team) made up of a teacher, administrators, health coordinator and a parent met this past Monday and reviewed the most recent guidance and local data on the CDC website. The link is here: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/covid-by-county.html

Ramsey County has been in the "green" for over three weeks it appears. The CDC is recommending that if a county is in green or yellow, masking can become recommended only. TCA also has had no reported cases of COVID for three weeks. We are also aware that as vaccines and boosters, along with KN95 and N95 masks become more readily available, people can now protect themselves more easily even if others are not masked around them.

Based on this information, masking at TCA will become recommended and not required beginning on March 28th. The IRT will be monitoring the CDC data weekly, and a link to CDC will be placed on TCA's website. If we see the data move back to red, masking will again be required at TCA. We do not anticipate this happening this spring, but we will be monitoring this closely.

We understand that all our decisions related to the pandemic have been difficult for everyone. Please know that we are focused on using science and data, and are proceeding with caution by giving us another three weeks to remain in the "green" zone before moving in this direction. Our first duty is always to protect our students, staff and families as we have navigated this situation. We continue to be focused on that, and also know that it does appear we may have ("knock on wood") finally turned the corner on the pandemic and are looking forward again to seeing all the smiling faces of our TCA community.

Hello Parents,

It is spring, and we are still COVID cautious. As we begin to take steps to returning to a more normal environment where we can actually SEE people's smiles, please remember that COVID has not disappeared.
