TCA Cell Phone Practice

After the past couple years, we have found the students are struggling with making appropriate decisions around phone use in classes. Because we want to help our students focus on their learning, TCA instituted a new practice around phones in the classroom. Students are not to use them during class for any reason. Students have individual chrome books assigned to use throughout their school day. The only time during the day that cell phone use is allowed is during lunch.

Health Corner



Health Forms

About 1/5th of the Health Forms for our student body have been returned to the Health Office. It is important that we receive updated Health Forms annually in case there have been any changes to your students' health that occurred over the summer. It is especially important for us to have basic knowledge of your student's health if they are new to TCA. I will be sending an email through Messenger specifically to families who have not yet completed a TCA Health Form. You can look for it over the weekend. Please do not send in health records from your physician, utilize the Health Form attached to the email. If you are unable to print the Health Form, please contact my office at this number 651-313-6571, or send an email to aseashore@twincitiesacademy.org and I will send one home with your student, or put one in the mail, whichever you deem most reliable. If you indicate on the Health Form that your student will be taking medication at school, even over the counter medications, TCA policy states that ALL medications need to be documented. I will also attach a Medication Administration Form to the email.

Immunizations

Many of you may have been reading the news and are aware that even diseases that in the past we believe to have been eradicated, such as Polio, can return to our communities if we allow our vaccine regimens to slip. If you are not sure your student is up to date on their immunizations, check in with your pediatrician. Legally, your student needs to be up to date on their vaccination schedule to be at school. The vaccines required by the state of Minnesota are:

Dtap 4-5 vaccines before 6th grade Tdap 1 at age 12 or prior to 7th grade MMR 2 before school age Hep B 3 before school age Meningococcal 2, 1 at age 12, one at age 16/required for high school seniors Polio 4 before school age Varicella (Chicken Pox) 2 before school age or doctor's note stating student has had chicken pox

You will receive an email from Messenger if your student is missing vaccines. If you receive an email regarding Vaccines/Immunizations, please contact your doctor right away to make an appointment to get caught up.



Health Corner



WHEN YOUR STUDENT IS ILL ...

When a student is sick, parents often wonder whether or not to keep a child at home from school.

If a child stays home and has the care they need when first sick, they will often get better faster. Staying home and resting will help the body fight the sickness. Staying at home is also one of the best ways to keep others from becoming ill.

Reasons why children should stay at home

Severe colds, coughs, or sore throats
Eye infections, especially if discharge is present
New skin rashes, especially if draining – unless medical opinion states rash is not contagious
Temperature of 100 or more with or without symptoms of an illness
Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or abdominal pain

6. Any other sign of acute illness

7. Until results of laboratory tests (i.e., throat culture, nasal swab, saliva test) are known.

Children may return to school when

Well enough to participate in normal school activities
Free of all symptoms for 24 hours (especially vomiting, diarrhea and fever)
Temperature remains normal for a 24-hour period without the use of fever reducing medications.
On an antibiotic for at least 24 hours

OR

5. Your healthcare provider states your child can return to school.

It is often difficult to decide whether it is really necessary to keep your child home. There are very few rules to follow when dealing with these variables.
