Driver's License steps for students 15 – 17:

- 30 hours of classroom instruction in order to get a “blue card”
- Take the “blue card” to a DVS office and take a permit test
- In order to get a license, permitted teens must take 6 hours of behind the wheel training, AND have 40 – 50 hours of supervised driving, AND have had their permit for at least 6 months.
