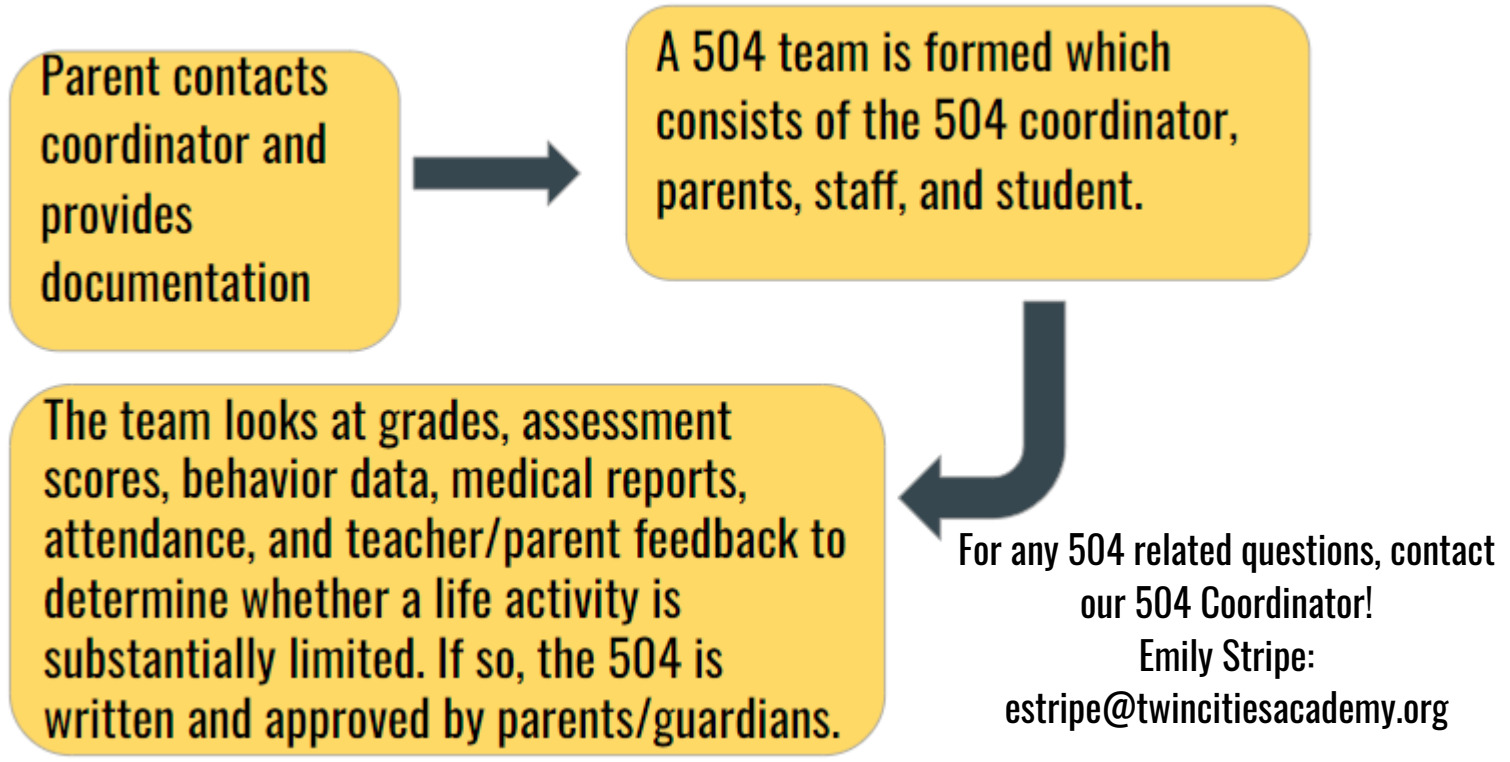
What is a 504 Plan?

The name refers to section 504 of the Disability Act of 1973 which prohibits discrimination of disabled individuals receiving federal funding. In the school setting, a 504 Plan is a legal document that outlines accommodations for an individual with a disability to protect them from unequal treatment.

..... What qualifies a disability for a 504?

A physical or mental diagnosis that “substantially limits a life activity” (walking, seeing, hearing, concentrating, learning, communicating, etc.)
